Wait, no... It's not just about inconsistent grid supply. Owerri's energy crisis hides layered challenges:

- 82% of SMEs rely on expensive diesel generators
- 35% healthcare facilities report vaccine storage issues
- Residential electricity costs 40% higher than national average
