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What Does a 100kWh Battery Really Cost?

Let's cut through the noise: when folks ask about 100kWh battery price, they're usually picturing something like Tesla's Powerwall scaled up. The Lithium-Ion Reality Check

BloombergNEF data shows lithium-ion pack prices fell to \$139/kWh in 2023. Simple math suggests a 100kWh battery should cost around \$13,900. But wait - that's cell cost only. Add thermal management, safety systems, and our proprietary AI controller, and you're looking at nearly triple that figure. Our engineers often joke that buying raw cells is like purchasing flour when you need a wedding cake.

Case Study: Solar Farm Storage
